Rocky Moretti, Pennsbury freshman, took the 120 pound bout to put the match score at 18-32. **Luke Lucerne** pinned the Falcon's Ryan McGurrin in 0:40. Pennsbury answered with 10-5 decision in the 132 pound match up and a 15-3 major to put the match out of reach for the Indians. **Cameron Robinson** ran a takedown clinic scoring 8 TDs before pinning Patrick Kirk in 2:54. That was **Cameron's** 99th win for his 3 year career at North. He will surely reach 100 in two weeks at Districts. Final score North 30 Pennsbury 40. The last time Council Rock North lost to Pennsbury was 13 years ago in the 2006-2007 season. BUMMER!
